

(2)	Discrimination	Review the job advertisements and the position to which they are being hired to determine whether the requirements focus on skills or gender. Interview the HR manager to understand the hiring procedures and the employee selection process. Interview the production manager to confirm the hiring date of the male and female workers. Inform management that this is a clear case of discrimination and request them to take corrective action.
