



Our vision is to see Member Firms & Certified Social Compliance Auditors (CSCA) as the Trusted professionals in Social Compliance Auditing.

To achieve this, APSCA developed a three-part examination program that recognizes the credentials of an auditor by awarding the *Certified Social Compliance Auditor (CSCA)* qualification.



Exam Process



Part I is a 2-hour multiple choice exam, delivered online



Part II is a 2-hour written case study exam, delivered online



Part III is a 2.5-hour simulated interview, delivered through video conference
